In most settings the first verse, with its extra note at the start, is repeated as the last verse and this means two bridges, one for verses 2-4 and one for the last verse. Use this latter bridge for *In our day of thanksgiving* to this tune (but see ***In our day of thanksgiving*** – ST CATHERINE'S COURT – p83). The play-over is best complete (last line illustrated), although first and last lines would suffice; shown here in D but you may prefer it in C.
